

#### Number of Students in the US





#### Estimated Percent of Student Seats Using Openstax =





- Challenge: Dual Credit course enrollment is increasing in popularity.
  - School districts often end up shouldering the cost for expensive dual credit textbooks.
- Opportunity: New TX policy (HB 3650) requires districts and IHE to consider OER in dual credit course offerings



# Impact of Zero Cost Books (ZCB) Adoption at Houston Community College

- ZCB courses were associated with an improved probably of passing over non-ZCB courses.
- The ZCB effect corresponds to an effect size (d) of 0.26

## The Struggle for Equity Education







- Student debt is still on the rise. Now nearly \$1.5T
  - Debt is racialized, and disproportionately impacts youth of color, especially black youth<sup>1</sup>
- 42% of community college students experience food insecurity<sup>2</sup>
- 51% of community college students experience housing insecurity<sup>2</sup>
- 12% of community college students were homeless<sup>2</sup>
