

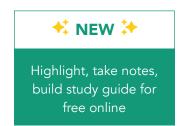
# Instructor getting started guide

## Report your adoption

Go to openstax.org/adoption to fill out our two-minute survey and let us know you're using OpenStax or recommending it as a resource. Your feedback will help secure funding to create new books.

#### Get the book

Visit openstax.org/subjects and select your book. Then choose your preferred format under "Get the book." We recommend online — our responsive design works seamlessly on any device.



## **Access instructor-only resources**

OpenStax books come with free instructor resources, along with additional low-cost resources like online homework and adaptive courseware from our OpenStax Allies. To get access to these resources, make an instructor account at https://accounts.openstax.org/signup. Then, once you've been verified, click on "Instructor Resources" on your book page on openstax.org.



## **Integrate with your Learning Management System**

### Make sure your text is available in your campus bookstore

Ask your bookstore to order print copies of your OpenStax book through XanEdu, so your students have the 5 option of purchasing a low-cost print version of their book if they prefer. We want to give students access to print options that suit their budget and course needs, so XanEdu offers both full-color hardcover versions and black and white paperback versions. Students can also buy directly from Amazon.
