It was called the "SID Message of the Day", and was designed as a way for SID management to communicate regularly with the workforce. (U//FOUO) Things have changed a lot in 12 months! The MOTD became SID *today* on March 31st, switching from a management message to a "SID newspaper" format. But beyond that, people are free (and encouraged) to voice their ideas.
